Many characteristics define what a disciple is or what he/she looks like. These 8 principles are all found in the Bible and tell us a little about the person and work of those who call themselves disciples of Jesus.

BUILD A DISCIPLE

1. Intentionally sets time aside daily to be with God.
 - a. Word & Prayer
2. Looking for additional ways to share your life with others.
3. Need to be with other people
 - a. Available to care
 - b. Surround yourself with other Christians who will hold you accountable and help you grow.
 - c. Asking questions of your spiritual mentors
4. Reads the Word, prays the Scriptures, meditates on what God is saying. Life application of the scriptures.
 - a. Able to apply the Bible in your personal context
 - b. Put biblical principles into your own words.
5. Aware of where Jesus is calling you
 - a. Involved with people far from Christ
 - b. Always starting new relationships
 - c. Initiate conversations about Christ
 - d. Creatively communicate the Good News
 - e. Always ready to give an answer to the hope that you have...
6. Gives thanks for all prayer answered and unanswered
 - a. P.R.A.Y. (Praise, Repent, Ask, Yield)
 - b. Recognizes the NO of God
7. Change in the way you speak, why you interact with others, what you do and where you do it.
 - a. Intentionality
8. Aware of how you are spending your life.
 - a. T.E.R.M. (Time, Energy, Reflection, Material Stuff)
 - b. Gives to church and community needs.
